# Livestock Trailer Rollover and Emergency Training for First Responders

Each day, there are several hundred thousand head of cattle that travel U.S. roadways. The Bovine Emergency Response Plan (BERP) was developed to provide training to local emergency responders to more effectively address accidents involving cattle transportation incidents.
